  - **Whitefield Road Verge Parking / New Pavement.** Thistle Homes Contractors had started on the pavement under the railway bridge. The secretary was asked to write to Colin Gilbert about the verge parking.
  - **Craigston Park.** The work on the paths was reported as being done.
  - **Hall Painting.** Cllr Wood would chase this.

**Keep Left Island Sign.** Cllr Wood would chase up the repair/replacement of the Keep left sign in Robertson Road, just west of Alldays.
