MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON WEDNESDAY 08th DEC 2004 AT 7.00PM IN THE JAMES ALLAN CENTRE, DUNFERMLINE.

1] **Madam Chairman's Welcome / Apologies:** Madam Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting Apologies were received from Kate Findlay (Treasurer)(Attending another Meeting at the City Chambers on Community Council Seminars), Graeme Whyte, Jessie Cartmell & Cllr. Les Wood (In Hospital) also Members of the public:- S Inglis & A Currie.

2] **Minutes:** The Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved with one amendment. They were moved by Donald Heigh and seconded by Lilah McKay.

3] **Matters Arising From Minutes:**

There were no matters arising from the minutes that were not catered for elsewhere in the Agenda, except concern over details of crime statistics listed in the police report, Cllr Tolson added that because these figures are being released into the public domain they appear worse, these figures are no worse than before.

4] **Madam Chairman's Report:** Madam Chairman stated that

1 The Coop grounds had been tidied up by a Landscaping contractor.

2 The mound of earth in the play park was still a problem; also the path way from Kinnaird Place to Robertson Road, Cllr Wood was looking into this.

3 Dog Fouling was still a problem; Cllr Wood was looking into this.

4 Lamp post in Adamson Crescent not been repaired yet???

5 Car parking on Robertson Road causing damage to the grass verge is very bad as of the 7th Dec 2004 there were 9 cars on the north side and 3 on the south opposite the Alderston Drive junction, also Whitefield Road, 3 cars sitting fully on the pavement causing the public foot path to be blocked also the south Hospital entrance road, cars parked fully down one side causing potential problems for Ambulance & Bus access, also the rear access to the Hospital was over parked. Cllr. Tolson stated the situation with Dunfermline Town Station car park was overcrowded due to more commuters using the facility and that all parties, e.g. Fife Council, Scot Rail & NHS etc. should be considered when action is to be taken regarding the parking issues. Madam Chairman said that if she had enough time she would monitor the use of this car park. The use of the Football Park car park on Robertson Road could be an alternative if it did not conflict with other Council uses.

what had happened were discussed. This triggered a general discussion about the named streets during different types of match, e.g. Celtic/Rangers or others, whether cones were deployed on one side of the street, basically you are not allowed to park your car on the pavement with 2 or 4 wheels at anytime, if you block the pavement in any way you can be fined. Discussions took place regarding all these issues and a Straw Poll was taken by Cllr Tolson to get the feeling of the attendees whether this Parking order should be rescinded, and was carried.
