Coop grounds update, letter received from Mr Paul Hepburn Facilities Manager The Cooperative Society, Robert Owen House Bath St. Glasgow, giving apologies and stating that they are responsible for the maintenance of all the surrounding area and locks have been fitted to the bins because of an ongoing problem. Shrub area tidied up and all bins cleaned up, still a possible problem with stealing out of the bins by a homeless person, hopefully the locks will help, the external gate is now being locked, we will monitor the situation.

Parking, Madam Chairman attended a meeting on 12/04/05 about Football Parking and was informed about A QMH parking issue about an order from the council about putting down Red lines where they are responsible, all the Yellow Lines around the Hospital now being official from 1st April. 27 cars were abandoned on pavements and grass verges are all ploughed up. Secretary to write to Police again to get the situation clarified.

Planning Applications, we have had no responses from the council about the objections we have submitted, will write to Douglas Sinclair, Chief Executive Fife Council.

Colliston Road Flooding, no response from the council about this problem, send letter to Brent Vivian Fife Council regarding the problem at between 88 & 90 Colliston Road.

Safety Barriers, to be fitted at Alderston Drive on the Paton St Lane also the barrier on the Paton St steps from Adamson Crescent to be repaired. Dave Paterson Confirmed that they were being dealt with.
