MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON WEDNESDAY 12th OCT 2005 AT 7.00PM IN THE JEAN MACKIE CENTRE, DUNFERMLINE.

- Madam Chairman's Welcome / Apologies: Madam Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting ... Apologies were received from Graeme Whyte, Jessie Cartmell & Cllr. Jim Tolson.
- 2] Minutes: The Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved. They were moved by Tom Brand and seconded by Janet Miller.

Matters Arising From Minutes:

Parking at Queen Margaret Hospital: The situation today was very bad, Commuters are possibly taking up spaces and also many cars are parking on pavements and on both sides of the access roads, this is a cause for concern. Cllr Wood stated that Car Park No 5 on the South Side of the Hospital, tender action is ongoing for the 100 extra spaces, hopefully complete by April 06. Contact police to enforce parking restrictions, especially on pavements.

Colliston Road flooding: This issue is still ongoing as this flooding problem is an issue for the Developer.

Play Park on Colliston Road: Wilma stated that it has been cleared??

Safety Barriers (Alderston Dv./Paton St. Lane & Adamson Cres./Paton St. Steps): Still not Fitted, ongoing.

Bus Shelter: Ongoing.

Robertson Road gardens: Boundary Fencing issue continuing, Police to monitor situation Whitefield Road Roundabout & Kingseat Road Lining: Roundabout scheduled for 2006.

Kick Pitches: No further problems, agreement to make them permanent.

Hectic Life Signage: A general discussion on signage, this is a continuing item for Cllr Tolson.

Traffic Regulations: Football parking restrictions, Proposals to be adopted.

Bellyeoman View Estate Open Space Maintenance: Dave Paterson to investigate details from the land registry, detail within deeds, then Community Council will take advice to letter all Tilbury residents. Colliston Road Residents Meeting: Date set for 26 October in the James Allan Centre, Paton St. all residents were invited by letter to attend.

CO-OP Bins: No response from the CO-OP e.g. Bins, Deliveries, Damaged wall & Erection of Community Notice Board. Vagrants are still rummaging in the bins during the day.

Play Park Alderston Drive: Very messy appears not to be cleaned up regularly by the council.

The situation is getting worse, a general discussion on the levels and frequency of Bus Service: service, were debated in great detail and improvements should be made to all services to serve the whole community. It was proposed to invite Mr Robert Andrew, Deputy Managing Director (Scotland) Stagecoach East Scotland, possibly at Cowdenbeath Depot.

Planning White Paper: Community Council response was for involvement at an early stage in the process to allow for input to the Planning applications and also include any different aspects which could affect the local neighbourhood e.g. open spaces and their maintenance.
