- 8] <u>Police Report</u> This was taken early to allow the officers to return to duty.

There have been no major crimes of note, Crime bulletins have been minimal. Starting this week there has been a Christmas Campaign in the High Street. They have a new toy, a Rapid Deployment Camera, which can be attached to a lamppost and monitored remotely. This can target Anti-Social Behaviour, there are now 4 officers now deployed on Bikes to be quickly be on site as necessary. All Pubs on board with Radios networked to the police, also shops. Youths are drinking alcohol on waste ground near Paton Street, Also Tesco Store on Dulloch Park is a problem. Bellyeoman School had been targeted for minor Vandalism. Derek commented on Parking on the pavement adjacent to the new Mini roundabout at the bottom of Townhill Road, all problems about this were discussed e.g. Road markings.
