- 1] **Madam Chairman's Welcome / Apologies:** Madam Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting ...
Apologies were received from Dave Paterson (Fife Council) & Graeme Whyte.
- 2] **Minutes:** The Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved. They were moved by Douglas Campbell and seconded by Donald Heigh.
- 3] **Matters Arising From Minutes:**
Bus Station Problems :- Cllr Mogg stated that contractors were doing remedial work, still problems. Cllr Mogg to investigate. Ongoing.
QMH :- Parking on Robertson Road & QMF, a general discussion took place, Derek stated several issues with a senior Director Retiring and Staff Parking being concentrated on this is an issue. All car parks will be connected with a one way system throughout; this should allow drivers to look for spaces in all car parks. William Duff is QMH transport Coordinator: Ongoing.
Leys Park Road Car Park:- Ongoing.
Sinclair Gardens Roundabout :- Ongoing.
Ground to North of School :- With Building Services. Ongoing
Pathway in Park (next to New Nursery) including Lighting at recycling area:- With Community Services. Ongoing.
Bellyeoman Road Pot Holes :- Most of them repaired, Pity they did not do them all, discussion on new pot hole repair system, hope this is used for the holes they left behind.
Coop Verge Damage :- Concrete repair system possible. Ongoing.
Robertson Road Parking :- Continuing Problem, can the verge be tarmaced.
33 Haig Crescent :- Nobody in these houses yet.
Buses :- Wilma stated that our bus service is atrocious and would like a face to face meeting with Stagecoach to follow up on all issues. Drivers are going the wrong way, going up Townhill Road instead of going along Bellyeoman Road, also missing out Alderston Drive & Lauriston Gardens. Wilma is to draw up a list of problems and offending times. Cllr Mogg to follow up with Transportation.
New Row Parking :- This is being looked into, possible Double Yellow Lines, Ongoing
Sponsorship of Roundabouts :- Fife Councillors to find out what Glenrothes is doing. Ongoing.
Weeds on Pavements :- Second spray of weeds is due, delayed due to bad weather, Ongoing.
