QMH & Robertson Road Parking:- Double yellow lines now installed, some issues, with parking on Robertson Rd at Aldertson Drive (East). An accident today on Whitefield Rd, serious, no information? Ongoing.

Leys Park Road Car Park:- Planning Permission granted for temp Car Park and Shuttle bus for Tesco lighting issues to be resolved. Taxi problem hopefully resolved. Ongoing.

Sinclair Gardens Roundabout :- Some areas still a bit of a mess. Ongoing.

Ground to North of School:- Path not being used, it won't be adopted until lighting installed. Funding available but no timescale for installation. Ongoing.

Pathway in Park (New Nursery) including Lighting at recycling area:- 2010/11 project. Ongoing.

Coop Verge Damage :- Plus Pothole. Ongoing.

New Row Parking :- Problems with people parking on the double yellow lines causing Single file traffic on East Port. Ongoing.

Cemetery Drains: - Still a problem no action to date. Ongoing

Dave Paterson's (Fife Council rep) replacement:- No action till September. Mary Siskou is the new Locality Manager. Ongoing.

Burnt out Dog bin behind Coop on lane, Still not replaced.

Balvaird/Alderston grass verge damage Still not Repaired.

Bus Stop Drain opposite Canmore Lodge:- Cllr McCulloch to investigate, Road realignment required
