3] Matters Arising From Minutes:

Bus Station Problems :-. No change Ongoing.

QMH & Robertson Road Parking:- Derek stated the meeting is this Friday? The problem has got worse, but Cllr Mogg has spoken to people in authority and once acute services are transferred to Kirkcaldy the problem will be resolved???. A general discussion took place on the general access problems during the day including all parking issues; Derek is to pass on Graeme's apologies to the Hospital Meeting. PC Thompson reported that in the area there have been 19 crimes, 5 thefts 5 breach of the peace, 4 vandalism 2 assaults, house breaking, 1 fraud and a traffic offence, hospital issues are taken separate, 3 assaults 2 vandalism 1 person drunk incapable, drugs offence and 1 theft, almost all in casualty, only 2 not been dealt with. House Breaking detected. Community engagement meetings report all crime figures down, On the spot fines figures dropping as people find that when you get caught you have a criminal conviction on your record for ever. PC Thompson stated that social behaviour offence reduced by 1420, due to instant Fines. Drugs, 14 premises searched, £76000 cash seized. No notable crimes in the area, operation Laser continuing. Community Engagement Meetings Possible meeting in QMH on Jan or Feb in 2011, still to be resolved due to a lack of response from Bellyeoman area residents. No problems in this area, flyers will be posted in due course. Beggar in Walmer Drive car park?
