## 3] Matters Arising From Minutes:

**Bus Station Problems :-**. Problems ongoing, potential re-alignment of shelters and more paving slab problems throughout the town, Crossing on New Row will be looked at in a years time, a general discussion took place and it was noted that this was wrong and should be looked at when the crossing needs repainted. **QMH & Robertson Road Parking:-** Derek updated the meeting of cancelled hospital meetings and a rescheduled meeting on 28<sup>th</sup> January, Derek wanted to meet Cllrs on site before this meeting and this was arranged. Several issues need to be addressed, over 90% of spaces are used by Staff and no spaces are available for patients, Cllr McCulloch stated yellow line issues will be addressed when the weather improves. Robertson Road Car Park spaces have been taken over with Salt and Portacabins. Issues that need to be addressed are Staff Parking, Travel plan etc.

Leys Park Road Car Park:- Lighting Still alight, Derek stated that all the snow was cleared off the roads and dumped in the car park SEPA were notified by residents. All council workers were using the car park during the bad weather. Cllr McCulloch stated that during the bad weather all council staff had to report to nearest Depot. Parking issues on many roads made them single track roads causing traffic problems. A general discussion took place on council priorities during the bad weather Cllr Burke to write to Ronnie Hynes

**Sinclair Gardens Roundabout:** - Plans to landscape this roundabout are in place, should the funding for this not be spent on the realignment of the lanes on Appin Crescent and the link road for a priority lane for St Margaret Drive as this would relieve congestion at busy times. Now not being sponsored and being payed out of budget, this should not be carried out with current spending restrictions.

**Ground to North of School:-** Lighting to be carried out 2010/11 Ongoing. outside school. Cycling Proficiency scheme at school funding to be looked into.

Pathway in Park (New Nursery) including Lighting at recycling area:- 2010/11 project. Ongoing. Coop Verge Damage:- Ongoing.

**New Row Parking: -** Still an issue, parking issues at the weekend. The police should take action. Ongoing. **Cemetery Drains: -** Still a problem, Ongoing.

Burnt out Dog bin behind Coop on lane, Still not replaced.

**Bus Stop Drain opposite Canmore Lodge:-** Still an issue, agreed to carry out resurfacing 2011 **Newsletter:-** Ongoing, Sylvia has volunteered to help including schools contacts. We have to find sources for funding for the next meeting; The Longer term view is for it to be self funding by advertising with a possible Circulation of 2500.

Traffic Calming on Kingseat Road: Kingseat Road traffic calming is acceptable.
