- 1] **Madam Chairman's Welcome / Apologies:** Madam Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting especially Mary Siskou as a council representative, it's been a long time since David Paterson moved on and also copies of minutes are being passed to other council members, this can only be a good thing. Apologies were received from Douglas Campbell, Sylvia Reddie, Cllr David Mogg, Cllr William McCulloch & Cllr Jim Burke.
- 2] **Minutes:** The Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as amended, with the word (incorrectly) removed at section 9. They were moved by Derek Moore and seconded by Jessie Cartmell.
- 3] **Matters Arising From Minutes:**
 - Bus Station Problems :-** Problems with paving stones and Bus shelter for our area is open to the elements and is not acceptable, ongoing.
 - QMH & Robertson Road Parking:-** Traffic problems were caused on Whitefield Road caused by vehicles backing up to get into the Hospital Car Park at 09:00 have no been resolved by opening the car park at 08:30, this allows staff to park in the patient car park earlier. The Hospital travel plan is not adequate for today's issues. Not had any response to the £10000 of matched funding available. Events superseded the letter to SOS and did not happen. Email responses to the problems are ongoing and all issues are on William Dove's desk. Problems with containers taking up parking places in the Robertson Rd overflow car park. Mary is to speak to transportation about this issue.
 - Leys Park Road Car Park:-** Council report into this is not valid on Lighting issues and is with Ronnie Hynds Fife Council seems to have ignored planning regulations.
 - Sinclair Gardens Roundabout:** - Landscaping, appears to be a waste of money? Maintenance will be an issue going forward. Could have been funded by Shopkeepers not tax payers, all proposed changes to the lane marking issues were explained to Mary and hopefully Lesley King (Fife Council) will understand.
 - Ground to North of School:-** Lighting started this will be an issue later when new work is carried out, a response to Leslie King explaining the situation will follow.
 - Pathway in Park (New Nursery) including Lighting at recycling area:-** 2010/11 project? No Budget in place, this is now in doubt. Ongoing, Mary to investigate.
 - New Row Parking:** - Ongoing with problems.
 - Cemetery Drains:** - Still a problem, Ongoing.
 - Bus Stop Drain opposite Canmore Lodge:-** Still an issue, agreed to carry out resurfacing 2011.
 - Traffic Calming on Kingseat Road:** Possible suggestion was to reduce the speed limit from the traffic calming down past the hospital to 30 mph. Ongoing
 - School 20 Speed limit:-** Richard stated that it was not being adhered to, ongoing problem.
 - Cheques** have been forwarded to Jean Mackie, Bellyeoman and the Scouts, with added thank you from Wilma as the money went towards new heaters for the hall.
 - Robertson Road, Derek stated that the large shrubbery at the Doctors Surgery was causing drivers travelling eastwards, a line of sight problems, with viewing nursery entrance.
