 - Ground to North of School:-** Lighting still ongoing. Cllr Mogg Stated there are proposals that Paton St. small Hall to be sold to Dunfermline Town Band?
 - Pathway in Park (New Nursery) including Lighting at recycling area:-** 2010/11 project? No Budget in place, this is now in doubt. Ongoing, Mary to investigate.
 - New Row Parking:** - Ongoing with problems.
 - Cemetery Drains:** - A Photo taken and a copy given to Stuart Nicholl by Cllr Burke. Problems discussed and to be kept in high profile, Water Tap to be reinstated. Ongoing.
 - Bus Stop Drain opposite Canmore Lodge:-** Still an issue, in programme to be completed. Resurfacing 2011.
 - Traffic Calming on Kingseat Road:** Cllr Mogg to look into the problems, Margaret Burns is the contact. Ongoing
 - School 20 Speed limit:-** Cllr Mogg asked for attendanmce at the next Community Engagement Meeting on 4th May and highlight this as an issue.
 - Night Time Noise Team:-** Awaiting Mary Siskou investigating.
 - Buses:-** Cllr Burke to find out if it is subsidised.
