- 1] <u>Madam Chairman's Welcome / Apologies:</u> Madam Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting.
- 2] <u>Minutes:</u> The Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved with amendments. They were moved by Douglas Campbell and seconded by Jessie Cartmell.

3] Matters Arising From Minutes:

Beech Hedging and Trees on Alderston Drive:- Trees & hedges cut back in way of bus shelter & edges sprayed for weeds, Cllr Law chased up all areas to be tidied up in the area this was probably one but more needs done.

QMH & Robertson Road Parking:- Derek and Graeme to attend the next travel Plan Meeting tomorrow. Derek stated that the current situation was only a respite future developments may cause problems. **Leys Park Road Car Park:-** Flooding and sewer overflowing problems needs to be addressed, no new drainage in car park and newly built flats not connected in yet, Cllr Law stated that all Robertson Rd drainage to be checked by lan Jones roads dept. Derek stated that photographs are available of problems in Leys Park Road.

Pathway in Park (New Nursery) including Lighting at recycling area:- Cheaper forms of lighting being looked into, also the cutting back trees to improve natural light. :-On-going

New Row Parking:- Cllr Law stated that pedestrianisation was going ahead. Cllr Mogg made comments on parking regulations, stating that double yellow lines were asked for. General discussion on all parking problems On-going.

Newsletter:- A copy of the new Newsletter was handed out and distribution was discussed, Google Maps to be used. On-going

Buses:- Wilma contacted stagecoach but did not invite a representative to attend, because of other issues. Many problems with town services, Changes to buses and timetable changes. Buses using James Street at no cost to operators. Problems with many services running empty. Kate to attend a meeting with the secretary of Fife Elderly Forum at New City House to discuss bus problems.

Grass Cutting;- Clippings left on pavements, Cllr Campbell stated that problems with lost cutting time due to the weather.:- Ongoing

Dog Warden:- Wilma introduced Mairi McArthur, Environmental Enforcement Officer, to the meeting and gave a brief description of the problems, Mairi's responsibilities cover all aspects of fouling and issuing of penalty notices. A general discussion took place on the issues. Contact Cards will be available in local shops.

8] Police Report:- The priorities in the area are Anti-Social behaviour, Sale of Alcohol and Speeding problems. Speeding removed from the priority list at the request of the meeting, but will still be



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getting attention, there were 10 traffic offences, detected crime figures, 12 assaults, 2 thefts, 8 vandalisms also a lot of effort put into solving the problem with car damage in the area. Scrap metal thefts on going, break ins to sheds. Extra officers are on the beat throughout Fife at the weekend. The next Community Engagement Meeting is at Townhill Community Centre on 6th Nov 2012, trying to arrange a talk on personal safety check and Bogus Workman.

ATM Presentation:- PC Thompson had a dummy ATM showing several ways that the security can be breached, showing items that have been found attached To ATM's to steel PIN Numbers also card details.
