MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON WEDNESDAY 12 Feb 2014 AT 7.00PM IN THE JEAN MACKIE CENTRE. DUNFERMLINE.

- 11 Madam Chairman's Welcome / Apologies: Madam Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting. Apologies were received from Cllr David Mogg,
- 21 Minutes: The Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved with amendments. Ken stated that a securing method for the green bin lid should be looked into, Cllr Law stated the council were aware of the problem. They were moved by Douglas Campbell and seconded by Jessie Cartmell.

Matters Arising From Minutes:

Lighting at recycling area:- Cllr Law stated the possibility of re-siting the Recycling bins, with a view to erecting a barrier. Some flatted properties require a 4 bin recycling area. - On-going.

Travelling People on Robertson Rd. -Wilma read out a letter from the Scottish Parliament from Cara Hilton (MSP) which she sent to Steve Grimmond (Fife Council Chief Exec) detailing all the problems in this area. Wilma reiterated that she did not say she did not have any objections for travellers using this site but did not object to travellers in general. - On-going.

Coop waste bin:- The current situation is better, Cllr Law to check with the estates, to ask John O'Neil to look into this. Wilma asked who owned the bin, Cllr Law looking into this: - On-Going.

Water Main Road Drain Cover Bellyeoman Road:- Ian Jones is still to investigate this problem .:- On-

Whitefield Road / Kingseat Road Junction: Traffic Lights to go ahead, road patching to take place - lan Jones: - On-going

QMH & Robertson Road Parking: One way system not implemented yet. - On-going

Leys Park Road Car Park:- Cllr Campbell won't be happy until after the main holiday period is over and there are no issues with coaches early in the morning. - On-going

New Row Parking:- Cllr Law stated that new traffic regulations which are coming in are slowly going to improve the parking situation. Traffic wardens have been at work throughout the town.: - On-going,.

Trees on Alderston Drive:- Cllr Campbell stated a further meeting to be with the Area Services

Manager is to take place looking at the various issues throughout the town . - On-going

Buses: - Meeting to be called in the Abbeyview Day Care Centre, chaired by Jim Leishman about buses with Stagecoach in attendance to answer questions. QMF buses being looked into, e.g. suitability ect. -On-going.

Parking at Nursing Home: - Cllr Law said the area is to be surveyed. Press report on cost of signage, Wilma stated that it took 3 Minutes to walk down from Paton St.:- On-going .

Wall at Townhill Road-Leys Park Road Junction:- Cllr Law has spoken to lan Jones about this Matter. - On- Going.

Hill of St Margaret's, Hedge & Trees:-Similar problem to Alderston Drive. - On-Going

Bellyeoman Rd: - Ian Jones missing Speed signs . - On-Going.

Lampposts:- lan Jones to investigate missing bus stop sign. - On-Going

Kerbstone Farnell Way: - Ian Jones felt it was not bad enough to replace yet.

Wind turbines:- Local meeting on how to have public consultation on the way forward.:- On-Going

Possible Affordable Housing:- Site at Paton St. in question?

Roads required before any Housing Developments.: Cllr Campbell to keep a look at this: On-Goina.
