MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON WEDNESDAY 12 Mar 2014 AT 7.00PM IN THE JEAN MACKIE CENTRE, DUNFERMLINE.

- 1] <u>Madam Chairman's Welcome / Apologies:</u> Madam Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting. Apologies were received from Richard Davidson & Cllr David Mogg.
- 2] <u>Minutes:</u> The Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved with amendments. They were moved by Douglas Campbell, and seconded by Jessie Cartmell.

3] Matters Arising From Minutes:

Lighting at recycling area:- Cllr Law stated that the lighting was no longer required as the recycling area was being relocated to Lorimer Gardens this will allow a barrier to be erected to stop caravans accessing the site, also work being done on drainage and fencing round the football pitch:- On-going. **Coop waste bin:**- Cllr Law to ask John O'Neil to look into this. Wilma asked who owned the site, to check with Council Estates:-On-Going.

Water Main Road Drain Cover Bellyeoman Road:- Ian Jones to supply update report:- On-going Whitefield Road / Kingseat Road Junction: Road patching to take place - Ian Jones. Complaints about Traffic Light Filter left, at bottom of Whitefield Road to be looked into:- On-Going

QMH, Robertson Rd Parking:- Work not started on the way system yet. - On-going

Leys Park Road Car Park:- Cllr Campbell won't be happy until after the main holiday period is over and there are no issues with coaches early in the morning. - On-going

New Row Parking:- Situation has improved :- On-Going

Trees on Alderston Drive:- Cllr Campbell stated that this will take a long time to sort out, issues being raised throughout Fife, a general discussion on the local situation took place, about Factoring arrangements that should have been put in place by the developers, but were not and the residents were responsible.: - On-going

Buses: - Meeting in the Abbeyview Day Care Centre will take place on the 18th March, chaired by Jim Leishman about buses with Stagecoach in attendance to answer questions. QMF buses being looked into, e.g. suitability etc. - On-going.

Parking at Nursing Home & Balfour Court: - Cllr Law stated that a traffic order has been actioned for double yellow lines at nursing home, Balfour Court has different issues.:- On-going.

Wall at Townhill Road-Leys Park Road Junction:- lan Jones to investigate:- On-going.

Hill of St Margaret's, Hedge & Trees:-Similar problem to Alderston Drive. - On-going

Bellyeoman Rd: - Ian Jones missing Speed signs . - On-going.

Lampposts:- Ian Jones to investigate missing bus stop sign on Alderston Drive.: - On-going **Wind turbines:**- Local meeting at Carnegie was a farce, giving details changes to turbine sizes and supplying wrong information, putting an Industrial unit on recreational land?, Bellyeoman CC not happy with consultation Meeting, Chris Ewing(Sen Man Renewals) said that this will fill the Funding Gap.:- On-Going

Land to the north of Alderston Drive/Paton Street Lane:- Helen Dolan (Reid) stated that this land was owned by her parents and was zoned for Housing in the Fife plan and a developer was interested but the possibility of a Wind Turbine would be a problem for this Development. The proposed wind turbine developer Phoenix does not seem to have a good track record. Discussions took place on all issues relating to planning and feasibility studies:- On-going

Community Council Meeting:- Graeme attended this meeting on behalf of Bellyeoman CC and stated the differing levels of concern, he read out a statement detailing all the issues, namely ;Northern Relief Road, Halbeath Road/Whitfield Road Junction, more information required. Roads required before any Housing Developments, including schools. Cllr Campbell to set up a meeting with CC's and Planners
