3] Matters Arising From Minutes:

Barrier at Football Park:- Recycling bins have been removed also salt mountains, awaiting New Barrier installation, repairs to fences being carried out. Response to Callum Farquhar sent :- Ongoing **Coop waste bin.**:- The Coop have put two new bins on site and removed the one that was fixed to wall of the Coop, CC to keep looking into this :-On-Going.

QMH, Robertson Rd Parking:- Work started on the way system, causing a bit of a problem. - On-going Leys Park Road Car Park:- Cllr Campbell is waiting to monitor this at the main Holiday Season. - On-going New Row Parking:- Still a problem, with parking, Zebra crossing in the wrong place :- On-Going Trees on Alderston Drive & Hill of St Margaret's, Hedge & Trees:- Cllr Campbell stated that Council Estates and Legal representatives are to have a meeting and Cllr Campbell is hoping to attend, the trees opposite QMF at bus stop area down to the bridge are in a bad way and need attention. : - On-going Buses: - No news from the Abeyview meeting, Cllr Campbell to find out. - On-going.

Parking at Nursing Home & Balfour Court: - Work still to be carried out at the Nursing Home, Balfour Court just to be monitored. :- On-going.

Wall at Townhill Road-Leys Park Road Junction:- This has changed ownership several times to be looked into. :-OnGoing.

Bellyeoman Rd: - Ian Jones, missing Speed signs. : - On-Going.

Lampposts:- Ian Jones to investigate missing bus stop sign on Alderston Drive.: - On-Going **Wind turbines:**- Chris Ewing(Sen Man Renewals) Cllr Campbell to invite him to the next CC meeting.

A general discussion on position and heights of Turbines:- On-Going

Land to the north of Alderston Drive/Paton Street Lane:- Development dependant on the result of Wind Turbine issue.:- On-Going

Community Council Meeting:- Cllr Campbell organised a meeting with planners on 30 April with attendance from Bellyeoman, Townhill & Kingseat CCs and Halbeath RTA.

Wind Turbines:- It was agreed that the Community Council would join other Community Councils in Dumfries and Galloway and elsewhere across Scotland in demanding that the Scottish Government declare a Moratorium pertaining to Wind Turbine applications to give local Councils and the public an opportunity to properly evaluate the impacts of these industrial developments in our countryside and towns. It was noted that Fife Council were reviewing their wind turbine proposals following the public meetings. As the one in Dunfermline had been a farce, we will wait for Chris Ewings' response :- On-Going.

Coop Roads:- Cllr Law stated that the entrance roads is to be repaired.:- On-Going.

Cath Wallace complaint about Trees at Playpark:- Bird damage to clothes, these trees were never going to be removed, it was only the shrub areas around the actual playpark. :-On-Going.

Cemetary Dumping:- Cllr Campbell awaiting a response.:- On-going

Leys Park Road Flats, Tidy up Site:- Is this site going to tidied, Cllr Law to chase this up. :- On-Going. **Alderston Court Damaged Verges:-** Cllrs to look at this as well as lowered kerb areas, also Parking issues on Criagston Park pavements and a Robertson Road Bus stop, Police involved. :- On-Going. **Parking at Queen Margaret Station and approaches.** :- Problems with parking on approach road at times, also kerbed areas in car park not available, can the paved areas be restored as spaces.
