MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON WEDNESDAY 11 JUN 2014 AT 7.00PM IN THE JEAN MACKIE CENTRE, DUNFERMLINE.

- 1] **Madam Chairman's Welcome / Apologies:** Madam Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting; Apologies were received from Kate Findlay, Jessie Cartmell, Richard Davidson, Cllr.Helen Law & Helen Keenan.
- 2] **Minutes:** The Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved with amendments. They were moved by Douglas Campbell and seconded by David O'Donnell.
- 3] **Matters Arising From Minutes:**
 - David taken first.**
 - Condition of Bellyeoman Rd.:-** The Condition of Bellyeoman Rd. is atrocious the road surface is damaged because of Buses grounding on the steep slope. This has caused damage to his car, he has taken photographs and forwarded copies to claims dept. of Fife Council.
 - Football Photographs.:-** Shown to CC of Foodbank Donation also U17 disclosure & Parental Consent for publishing in Newsletter.
 - Request for Matchballs:-** The football team require balls for match days costing £24.99 Mitre Promax Match Winner. JD proposed £100 for 4 Balls seconded by SR
 - Barrier at Football Park:-** Graeme had concerns over access from other areas at Football Ground also the Bin allocation should be looked at because of the usage on sporting days:- Ongoing
 - Travelling People:-** Seasonable site required, Cllr Campbell said that Fife is looking for areas, Council require more powers, Wilma stated that at the Kelty site, payment is taken for site rent fees, space is kept free for them, no one is allowed to use this space.
 - Coop waste bin:-** Slightly better and hopefully sorted out :-On-Going.
 - QMH, Robertson Rd Parking:-** Taylor Wimpey working on Hospital rearranged parking. - On-going
 - Leys Park Road Car Park:-** Cllr Campbell is waiting to monitor this at the main Holiday Season. - On-going
 - New Row Parking:-** Cllr Campbell along with Colleagues had walk through Town Centre looking at all areas and the crossing at the New Row was brought up :- On-Going
 - Trees on Alderston Drive & Hill of St Margaret's, Hedge & Trees:-** Cllr Campbell stated that this has been raised to Corporate Level, meeting still not arranged. Meanwhile the Colliston Road area, the trees are out over the pavement, Graeme stated that factoring should be arranged through the council, Sylvia stated that a Factor should be appointed to send out letters to residents this was all discussed, Nancy stated that some residents refused to pay anything as title deeds did not state this responsibility Cllr Campbell is still actively following this with the Council, Blue sheds at QMF possible Social Enterprise Initiative Solution, because the builder went bust is a possible solution: - On-going
 - Parking at Nursing Home & Balfour Court:** - Double Yellow lines painted but still parking on them, Cllr Campbell to check this out. :- On-going.
 - Bellyeoman Rd:** - Ian Jones, missing Speed signs. :- On-Going.
 - Lampposts:-** Ian Jones to investigate missing bus stop sign on Alderston Drive.: - On-Going
 - Community Councils Meeting:-** Graeme stated that a big thank you to Gordon Harvey of the Halbeath Residents and Tenant's Association and Cllr Campbell for facilitating all the meetings, Plans for north Dunfermline SES plan, First Stage plans for various areas were under discussion. All areas have to take the gas pipeline into consideration. Graeme to forward all information, discussions took place on the proposed development to the East of Whitefield Rd. Possible that the only main problems were the proposed New northern Link Rd. also the Educational requirements. Proposed new station at P&R Halbeath under discussion:- On-Going

 - Leys Park Road Flats, Tidy up Site:-** Is this site going to be tidied, to chase this up:- On-Going.
